NELSON BY THE NUMBERS: 2009 YEAR-IN-REVIEW

KAUKAUNA – Assembly Majority Leader Thomas Nelson (D-Kaukauna) released information today about his constituent outreach efforts in 2009. Among the highlights, Representative Nelson made 9,466 personal door-to-door visits and assisted 2,571 constituents.

“Reaching out to and helping constituents is the most important part of my job,” said Representative Nelson. “It is the reason I entered public service and, at the halfway point of this term, I am pleased with the results.”

Before taking office in 2005, Representative Nelson pledged to be readily available to residents of the Fifth Assembly District. He has sustained that pledge since the very first day. Although the Legislature tackled significant challenges in 2009, Representative Nelson continued to prioritize constituent service.

“I am committed to making Wisconsin’s government work better for the people of Northeastern Wisconsin, especially in these difficult economic times,” said Representative Nelson.

Representative Nelson also thanked his office staff, particularly the interns who volunteered their time throughout the year.

“My staff and dedicated interns continue to make our office one of the hardest working offices in the State Capitol,” said Representative Nelson. “Without their hard work and commitment, none of this would be possible.”

Highlights of Representative Nelson’s 2009 outreach efforts include:

- 9,466 personal door-to-door visits;
- 2,571 constituents cases;
- 269 community events and meetings; and
- 47 listening sessions.

“While the Legislature will continue efforts to get our economy back on track in 2010, I look forward to maintaining the high-level of service that the people of the Fifth Assembly District deserve,” said Representative Nelson.
