MAJORITY LEADER NELSON: STIMULUS PACKAGE AGGRESSIVE FIRST STEP DOWN
PATH TO ECONOMIC RECOVERY

MADISON – Assembly Majority Leader Thomas Nelson (D-Kaukauna) released this statement following the joint press conference on the state economic stimulus package.
