MAJORITY LEADER NELSON PLEASED WITH
FLOOR SCHEDULING OF KEY JOB GROWTH BILLS

MADISON — Assembly Majority Leader Thomas Nelson (D-Kaukauna) released this statement following approval of the January 27th session calendar by the Assembly Committee on Rules.

“I am pleased to report the swift action taken on two key bills designed to spur job creation and economic growth during the first meeting of the Assembly Committee on Rules.”

“The American Jobs Act and the Wisconsin First legislation will be brought to the full Assembly next week. The number one priority of the Assembly Democrats is to grow our economy and create good-paying, family-supporting jobs in Wisconsin.”

“These bills invest our taxpayer dollars where they belong – in Wisconsin. The American Jobs Act will stop the state from purchasing goods and contracts from companies that ship jobs overseas. The Wisconsin first legislation will require the state to purchase a percentage of goods and services from Wisconsin-based businesses.”
